Riesling has had its up and downs over the centuries. At its peak, it commanded prices surpassing the wines of Bordeaux and Burgundy. Recently, it was often relegated to the grocery stores bottom shelf. Riesling is amidst a renaissance. While the first written evidence of the vine comes from a 1435 receipt from Kloster Erbacher Monastery in Germany's Rheingau region, Riesling has taken root in nearly every viable grape growing region in the world.

Riesling wine styles have shifted over the centuries, but this summer RN74 pays homage to the grapes original German roots and style by featuring two **dry Rieslings**, and a modern slightly sweet style.
